ECSM is now a well-established event on the academic research calendar and now in its 11th year the key aim remains the opportunity for participants to share ideas and meet the people who hold them. The scope of papers will ensure an interesting two days. The subjects covered illustrate the wide range of topics that fall into this important and ever-growing area of research.

The opening keynote presentation is given by Dr Martin De Saulles, Principal Lecturer at The University of Brighton on *Establishing Trust in an AI-driven Economy*. On the second day, Dr Tony Sampson from The University of Essex, will give a talk on the subject: *Return to Virality: Contagion Theory in the Age of Social Media*.

With an initial submission of 138 abstracts, after the double blind, peer review process there are 37 Academic research papers, 7 PhD research papers, 2 Masters Research papers and 2 work-in-progress papers published in these Conference Proceedings. These papers represent research from Canada, China, Colombia, Czech Republic, Finland, Germany, Ghana, Greece, Hungary, India, Iraq, Israel, Japan, Kuwait, Lithuania, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Philippines, Portugal, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Slovak Republic, Slovakia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, The Netherlands, Türkiye, UAE, UK, USA and Vietnam.

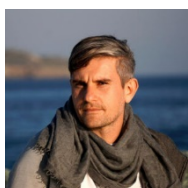
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Biographies

Dr Tony D. Sampson is reader in digital communication at the University of Essex. His publications include *The Spam Book* (Hampton Press, 2009), *Virality: Contagion Theory in the Age of Networks* (University of Minnesota Press, 2012), *The Assemblage Brain: Sense Making in Neuroculture* (University of Minnesota Press, 2017) and *Affect and Social Media* (Rowman and Littlefield, 2018). His latest book, *A Sleepwalker's Guide to Social Media*, was published by Polity in 2020. He is currently

writing a critical theory book on the pervasive influence of UX design principles on contemporary life from cradle to grave. The book is provisionally titled *Ubiquitous UX: The Struggle for [USER] Experience*. Tony is a co-founder of the Cultural Engine Research Group (CERG) and organizer of the Affect and Social Media conferences in East London.



Dr Martin De Saulles is a Principal Lecturer at the University of Brighton where he teaches and carries out research in the areas of innovation and marketing. Martin has authored research papers and several books on these topics and is currently writing a book on the emerging data-driven AI revolution due for publication at the end of 2024. As well as his academic work, Martin helps B2B technology-based businesses with their marketing strategies.
